

BAKER TILLY CATALYST LLP SCHOLARSHIP FUND

In 2011, The Baker Tilly Catalyst LLP Scholarship Fund was established to acknowledge the choice of Between Friends staff that directs their summer employment in support of providing memorable and meaningful experiences for people with disabilities. The Baker Tilly Catalyst LLP Scholarship Fund was inspired by a parent who is also a partner with Baker Tilly Catalyst, a multidisciplinary professional service firm that provides accounting, assurance, taxation, financial planning, wealth management, and corporate advisory services. Through Between Friends - Camp Bonaventure, both our members and their parents encountered the positive and enriching experience our programs and camps provide. Recognition is given to the Between Friends staff for their contribution in creating engaging and challenging programs for the participants.

- Two (2) scholarships, a maximum of \$1,000.00 each, will be awarded to two separate individuals employed with Between Friends' summer programs. These programs include: Camp Bonaventure and Adventurers.
- Eligible individuals are required to fulfill their contractual obligation for one of the aforementioned Between Friends summer programs.
- One (1) scholarship will be awarded to an individual who is currently enrolled in or pursuing enrollment in a field related to: Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Recreation Therapy, Physiotherapy, Disability Studies, Community Rehabilitation, or Social Work.
- One (1) scholarship will be awarded to an individual currently enrolled in or pursuing enrollment in any academic field. (i.e. Education, Engineering, Arts, Trades, Computer Science, Law, Finance, etc.).
- All Scholarships will be awarded based on involvement with Between Friends, the impact their experience has had on their personal or professional life, and/or how they have impacted Between Friends.
- Scholarship recipients must submit receipts and proof of successful completion of the course/semester. Failure to submit requirements will result in forfeit of the scholarship.
- The full scholarship amount will be awarded to the appropriate recipients at the Between Friends Annual Awards Ceremony, which typically occurs in May.
- Applicants are limited to receiving one (1) scholarship through Between Friends per calendar year.
- Previous scholarship recipients must wait for one full calendar year before re-applying.
- Baker Tilly Catalyst LLP Scholarship recipients will be announced to the public by January 31, 2026.
- All scholarship winners will receive public acknowledgment on the Between Friends website, and any other outlets, if so chosen.

All applicants are required to submit:

- The attached application form
- One (1) page typewritten, one-and-a-half spaced essay, which **MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:**
 - The summer program the applicant was involved in
 - How the course/area of study will directly impact Between Friends
 - How Between Friends has impacted the applicant
 - How the applicant has impacted Between Friends, persons with disabilities, and the general community
 - How and why the funds will be of a benefit to them in their educational pursuits
- Proof of enrollment in a post-secondary institute or applicable course

All applications, including the admission essay, will be submitted to the Honorary & Scholarship Committee.
